Supplies to bring from home:

Needle
Cut-off wire
Carpenter's right angle
Very sharp knife like an exacto or Dolan DPT220
Soft rubber ribs (Sherrill red/yellow/green ribs or Kemper blue rubber ribs)
Kemper metal ribs (S1 and S10 with serrated edge)
Kemper wooden tool WT 12
Old brush and small container for magic water
Sponge
Rasp (surform or Sherrill rasp)
Pony roller
Whatever you like decorating with such as stamps, brushes, tools, etc.

In this class we will discuss design of lidded containers, focusing on working with soft slabs in creating soft, fluid, organic forms and architectural stacked forms. Templates will be used to create folded hollow handles and knobs. We will experiment with texture and pattern as decoration.
